About CYFI Network Response Program

The CYFI Network Response Program (CNRP) connects CYFI affiliated consultants with organizations and institutions across the world that seek technical assistance in promoting and implementing economic citizenship at the national and local level. The purpose of the CNRP is to leverage the expertise of the CYFI network by connecting organizations seeking technical assistance in the formulation, design and implementation of policies and programs to those who are well-equipped to help them to reach their maximum potential.

How Can You Benefit from CNRP?

The CNRP will potentially provide you with business opportunities as the CYFI Secretariat will recommend you to relevant clients whose projects match your skills, experience, and price range. In addition, the CNRP offers invaluable networking opportunities as well as numerous possibilities to learn new skills. What's more, as a member, you will receive an official CNRP certificate, which proves that you are acting in line with and contributing to CYFI's goals and activities. Finally, registration with the Network Response Program is free of charge.

Who Will You Be Working With?

In general, the CNRP can help a wide variety of organisations with different types of requests, such as:

- **National Education Authorities** looking for support to design and implement a national program and/or incorporate elements of Economic Citizenship Education into the formal education system.
- **National Financial Authorities** looking for support to design and implement a national financial inclusion program and introduce Child and Youth Friendly banking regulations.
- **Civil Society Organizations** working on the general themes of financial inclusion and/or education of children and youth looking for support to improve their existing programs to develop new business opportunities.
- **Private Sector Representatives** (financial service providers and other corporate entities) who wish to become more Child and Youth Friendly by adapting products and services or by launching an integrated program for financial access and educational services.

Who Can Join CNRP?

We are looking for consultants with a wide range of skills and experience who can handle a wide variety of requests, ranging from designing a national financial education curriculum to assisting private sector representatives in offering Child and Youth Friendly financial products. Ideally, we are looking for expertise in the following areas:

- **Education** (teacher training, curriculum development, curriculum assessment, education regulation, workshop facilitation, financial education programming, vocational training, youth entrepreneurship, non-formal education and e-learning etc.)


- **Finance** (product development, financial regulation, non-formal savings and loans associations, integrated financial and educational services, etc.)
- **Project management** (stakeholder engagement, strategic planning, youth project management/coordination, impact assessment, etc.)
- **Communications** (marketing, technological platforms for education or financial services, translation, etc.)

CYFI expects that CNRP Associates adhere to CYFI’s goals and methodology. All work done by CNRP Associates will be considered CYFI projects and be part of the CNRP package, which includes existing CYFI frameworks, such as the Guide to Economic Citizenship Education and the Child and Youth Friendly Banking Principles. This package incorporates all theoretical and practical aspects of the CNRP, from the analysis and consulting to the production and implementation of financial inclusion/education programs.

How Does CNRP Work?

The CNRP consists of a set of easy-to-follow steps (see the graph below):

- A client submits a request form online for services from the CNRP.
- CYFI provides the client with relevant documents detailing formal terms and conditions and other relevant information on the CNRP.
- CYFI performs an internal assessment of the request for advisory services and determines whether it will carry out the project with CYFI Secretariat staff or sub-contract suitable external consultant affiliated with the CNRP.
- A consultancy contract is agreed on and signed on behalf of CYFI with the consultant
- Once the project is executed, it enters the closing stage including discussions on follow-up procedures between the client, the consultant and CYFI
